

GLOSSARY OF TECHNICAL TERMS

This glossary of technical terms contains explanations of certain terms used in this prospectus in connection with the Group and its business. This terminology and the given meaning may not correspond to the standard meaning and usage adopted in the industry.

“aluminium ingots”	aluminium ingots are alumina that has been cast into convenient shapes which will later be remelted to produce parts and components of motorbikes
“cub”	a cub is a motorbike with a manual transmission on which the rider sits with one leg on each side of the engine
“jig”	a jig holds all the frame parts and the wheel dropouts in alignment during the assembly of a motorbike to ensure that the frame is symmetrical and straight and that all the components are at the correct angle and position
“MPV”	a multi-purpose vehicle, a type of vehicle which has a body that resembles a van but which typically has rear side doors, rear side windows, and interior fittings to accommodate passengers similar to a station wagon or estate car
“plastic resin pellets”	plastic resin pellets are plastic melted into small pellets which will later be remelted to produce motorbike parts and body panels
“scooter”	a scooter is a motorbike with an automatic transmission and a step-through frame on which the rider sits without straddling any part of the engine
